WHY DO WE DO WHAT WE DO?

- **There are nearly 2 million orphans in Tanzania today.** —Unicef
- **45% of the population of Tanzania is under the age of 15.** —World Health Organization
- **Unsupported OVCs are nearly twice more likely to drop out of school than non-OVCs.** —Unicef

OUR THEORY OF CHANGE

Providing holistic support to most vulnerable children will positively influence attitudes of communities, civil society actors, and the government to secure quality education, child protection, and equity in development. The pre-conditions are:

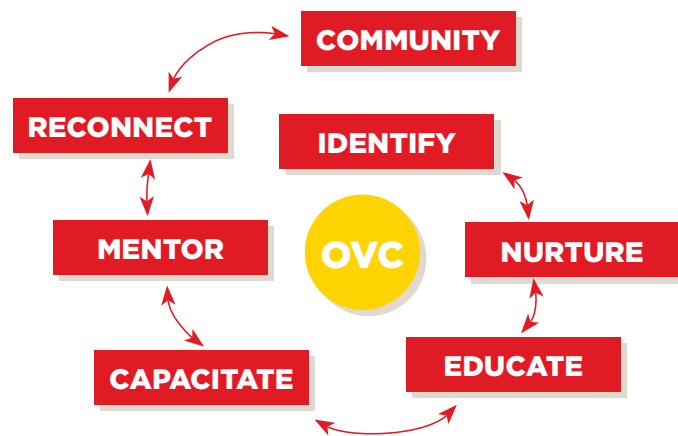
If vulnerable children are effectively identified and provided with sponsorship, then they will access education

OUR PROGRAMS

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

TFFT believes in a just world where all children have equal access to quality education. TFFT's comprehensive Scholarship Program provides Tanzania's most vulnerable children the opportunity to receive quality education at private boarding school. TFFT also provides personalized developmental guidance, career coaching and mentorship, and for their basic needs (such as toiletries, shoes, clothes and stationaries). For school holidays, we either reunite scholars with living relatives or match them with a foster family. During their 12 years with us, the TFFT team teaches the scholars to care for themselves, bursts with pride at their graduations, celebrates their achievements, and nurtures their dreams.

PSYCHO-SOCIAL & HEALTH PROGRAM

TFFT believes that sending scholars to school while ignoring the psychosocial and health component will act against them reaching their potentials. This program addresses our scholars' psychosocial needs to ensure that they are emotionally, physically, and mentally healthy. We also make sure they live within a conducive family environment that holistically integrates with the other program runs within TFFT.

HOW:

- Counseling
- Medical Care
- Livelihood strengthening for relatives and guardians
- Capacity building for orphanages

FULL CIRCLE

TFFT believes in the limitless potential of orphans and vulnerable children. Full Circle aims to fill the void of the life lessons typically taught in a healthy home environment. Full Circle teaches essential life skills, stretches students' imagination, fuels their dreams, builds confidence, and deepens personal understanding. This empowers participants to become independent, compassionate adults who are able to lead productive lives and are prepared to work collaboratively with their communities to address the issues facing their country.

HOW:

- Provide life skills education to students through after-school programs, classes, school clubs, and extra-curricular activities.
- Train teachers and school administrators in implementing life skills education programs and club management at their schools.
- Provide curriculums and resources to life skills teachers.

TEACHER TRAINING

TFFT believes quality education transforms lives and that teachers and school leaders both play key roles in achieving this. TFFT's Teacher Training Program works to improve the quality of instruction and management in primary and secondary schools and to ensure that schools are child-friendly, non-stigmatizing, gender-sensitive, and supportive of the needs of orphans and vulnerable children.

HOW:

- In-Service Teacher Training
- Training of Trainers
- Capacity-building for school management teams
- Search for Outstanding Teachers
- Publication of best practices and researched-based teaching methodologies by and for teachers
