

THE LEARNING CENTRE

The learning centre will be conveniently located within the Arusha Region off the main road with access to water, electricity, and public transportation. It will be less than one mile from the bus station and 20 miles from Kilimanjaro International Airport, ensuring broad access and impact.

Library and Resource Centre

In Tanzania many libraries do not let visitors borrow their precious books. Our 50,000-book public lending library will encourage patrons to take full advantage of its resources. For those struggling to feed their families or students wanting to supplement their classroom education, the freedom to utilize materials outside of the library facility will promote literacy and learning in powerful ways.

Technology and Computer Training Centre

Internet connectivity is a luxury few can afford in Tanzania. Our computer lab will offer public access to the web for research as well as online training. TFFT will host training on everything from basic computer and typing skills, to more advanced courses on MS Office and coding.

Higher Education Advisory and Scholarship Centre

Navigating higher education, admissions, and financial aid processes is daunting and prevents many from pursuing continued study. A trained professional will help students navigate this as well as administer tests such as SAT, ACT, and TOEFL.

Teacher Training and Literacy Lab

This centre will house our teacher training courses. Lack of basic literacy persists as a significant problem in Tanzania. To maximize impact, the centre will have a dedicated staff to provide individualized help to increase literacy rates. Supplementary workshops, exhibits, and seminars on life-skills will also run out of this centre.

NGO and Social Entrepreneurship Incubator

Inspired by the highly successful start-up tech incubators and accelerators, we will house grassroots, early-stage NGOs and social enterprises. Participants will have 18 months to develop their ideas and launch their initiatives, while benefiting from experience, collaboration, and mentorship.

TFFT Offices, Conferencing and Meeting Facility

This space will offer a vibrant home for the “TFFT Family” that is essential to continuing the life and strength of our organization.
